Hayward Tyler – New order update

The Directors of Specialist Energy Group plc (AIM: SEGR.L), the specialist engineering group, are pleased to announce that its wholly owned subsidiary Hayward Tyler Group Ltd (“Hayward Tyler”) has won new orders worth almost £3 million.

In India, Hayward Tyler will be supplying nine Boiler Circulation Pumps (“BCP’s”) to Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd (“BHEL”), the largest engineering and manufacturing enterprise in India in the energy-related/infrastructure sector. BHEL will use the pumps, which are a subcritical design, in two new power station projects: Shree Singaji and Avathar Bandhar. The BCP’s are due to be delivered in 2011 and brings the total number of pumps recently ordered by BHEL to over 25. The order is worth in excess of £2million.

In China, Hayward Tyler has also received over £0.7million order for two Supercritical BCP’s for Shanghai Boiler Works Ltd’s (“SBW”) Xing Hai power station project. SBW is China’s leading supplier of boilers to the Chinese power industry.

Ewan Lloyd-Baker, Chief Executive Officer of SEG plc, commented:

“India and China are key markets for Hayward Tyler. In line with the recent interim announcement we are delighted to be growing our order book through extending our presence in these important export markets. We continue to focus the business on providing mission critical equipment to end markets that have significant growth potential.”
